MATERIALS

Schachenmayr Julie Color, 150 g ball

Approx. 150 g \approx 337 m

Col. 00080 (rainbow) 1, 1, 1, 1 ball

Yarn amounts are approximate. Make sure to purchase enough of the same dye lot in order to complete your project. The color names refer to the German names on the sleeves. The amount of yarn needed approx. vary from person to person.

1 circ. needle 5,0 mm (US size 8) en 5,5 mm (US size 9), 80 cm long

1 circ. needle 5,0 mm (US size 8), 40 cm long

1 stitchholder

1 tapestry needle for weaving in ends

GAUGE

Stockinette stitch, using needle size 5.5 mm:

16 st and 24 rows = $10 \times 10 \text{ cm}$

THE BASICS

Ribbed pattern using needle size 5.0 mm:

RS: k1, p1 in alternation, WS: work the st as they appear.

Stockinette stitch, using needle size 5.5 mm:

RS: knit, WS: purl.

Increases:

Lift the thread between the left and right needles and knit into the back loop.

INSTRUCTIONS

Instructions are for smallest size, with changes for larger sizes noted in different colors. When only one figure is given, it applies to all sizes.

Back

Using the 5.0 mm needle and Rainbow, cast on 47/49/51 st and work in the border pattern for 3 cm. Change to the 5.5 mm needle and work in stockinette st, increasing 6 st, evenly spaced, in the first stockinette st row = 53/55/57 st. When the piece measures 19/20/21 cm from the cast-on edge, shape armholes: bind off 2 st at each edge, then dec 1 st after or before each selvage st in every other row 3x = 43/45/47 st.

When the piece measures 33/35/37 cm from the caston edge, bind off all st. The center 23 st will form the back neckline; the outer 10/11/12 st on each side will form the shoulders.

Front

Work the same as the back, but with a V-neck opening. When the piece measures 19/20/21 cm from the cast on edge, place the center st on a safety pin and continue working the two sides separately, decreasing 1 st at each neck edge in every other row 6x and decreasing 1 st after or before the selvage st in every 4th row 5x.

When the piece measures 33/35/37 cm from the cast-on edge, bind off the remaining 10/11/12 M on each side for the shoulders.


FINISHING OFF

Dampen and block all pieces according the measurements; allow to dry.

Join shoulder and side seams.

V-neck edge

Using the short 5.0 mm circular needle and Rainbow, pick up and knit 72/74/76 st evenly spaced around the neckline as follows: 23/23/23 st from the back neck, 24/25/26 st from left side of the V-neck opening, slide the st from the safety pin onto the needle, 24/25/26 st from the right side of the V-neck opening; join to work in the round, placing a marker at the beginning of the round. Work in the border





pattern in rounds, beginning each Rd with a knit/purl/knit st. The st in the center front is a knit st. In every Rd, including the bind-off Rd, slip this center st knitwise together with the previous st, knit the next st, then pass the slipped stiches over. When the border measures 2.5 cm, bind off all st loosely as they appear.

Armhole borders

Using the short 5.0 mm circular needle and Rainbow, pick up and knit 40/42/46 st at each armhole edge and join to work in the round. Place a marker at the beginning of the round. Work in the border pattern for 2.5 cm, then bind off all st loosely as they appear.

Weave in all ends.
