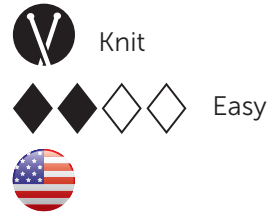

# Lia Child's cardigan

Recommended Yarn

Width at the bottom	33	35	39	42
Length to beginning of armhole	28	30	32	35
Width armhole	3	3	4	4
Height armhole	14	15	17	18
Shoulder width	6,5	7,5	7,5	9
Neck width	14	14	16	16
Neck height front	14	15	17	18
Total length	42	45	49	53
<b>Sleeves</b>				
Width at the bottom	16	18	20	20
Width at the top	28	30	34	36

## MATERIALS

Schachenmayr Julie Color, 150 g ball  
Approx. 150 g ≈ 337 m  
Col. 00080 (rainbow) 2, 2, 2, 3 balls

Yarn amounts are approximate. Make sure to purchase enough of the same dye lot in order to complete your project. The color names refer to the German names on the sleeves. The amount of yarn needed approx. vary from person to person.

1 circ. needle 5,0 mm (US size 8) en 5,5 mm (US size 9), 80 cm long  
1 circ. needle 5,0 mm (US size 8), 120 cm long  
5 buttons  
1 tapestry needle for weaving in ends

## GAUGE

**Stockinette stitch, using needle size 5.5 mm:**

16 st and 24 rows = 10 x 10 cm

## THE BASICS

**Ribbed pattern using needle size 5.0 mm:**

RS: k1, p1 in alternation, WS: work the st as they appear.

**Stockinette stitch, using needle size 5.5 mm:**

RS: knit, WS: purl.

## Increases:

Lift the thread between the left and right needles and knit into the back loop.

## INSTRUCTIONS

Instructions are for smallest size, with changes for larger sizes noted in different colors. When only one figure is given, it applies to all sizes.

### Back

Using the 5.0 cmm circular needle and Rainbow, cast on 55/59/65/69st st and work in the border pattern for 4 cm. Change to the 5.5 mm needle and continue working in stockinette st.

When the piece measures 28/30/32/35 cm from the cast-on edge, shape the armholes: decrease 1 st at each edge inside the selvage st every other row 5/5/6/7x = 45/49/53/55 st.

When the piece measures 42/45/49/53 cm from the cast-on edge, bind off all st. The center 23/25/27/27 st will form the back neckline; the 11/12/13/14 outer st on each side will form the shoulders.

### Left front

Using the 5.0 mm needle and Rainbow, cast on 27/29/32/34 st and work in the border pattern for 4 cm. Change to the 5.5 mm needle and continue working in stockinette st.

When the piece measures 28/30/32/35 cm from the cast-on edge, shape the armhole: at the right-hand edge of the work, decrease 1 st after the selvage st in every other row 5/5/6/7x.

At the same time, when the piece measures 28/30/32/35 cm from the cast-on edge, shape the neck opening: at the left-hand edge of the work, decrease 1 st before the selvage st in every other row 6x, then in every 4th row 5/6/7/7x.

When the piece measures 42/45/49/53 cm from the cast-on edge, bind off the remaining 11/12/13/14 st for the shoulder.



### Right front

Using the 5.0 mm needle and Rainbow, cast on 27/29/32/34 st and work in the border pattern for 4 cm. Change to the 5.5 mm needle and continue working in stockinette st.

When the piece measures 28/30/32/35 cm from the cast-on edge, shape the neck opening: at the right-hand edge of the work, decrease 1 st after the selvage st in every other row 6x, then in every 4th row 5/6/7/7x.

At the same time, when the piece measures 28/30/32/35 cm from the cast-on edge, shape the armhole: at the left-hand edge of the work, decrease 1 st before the selvage st in every other row 5/5/6/7x.

When the piece measures 42/45/49/53 cm from the cast-on edge, bind off the remaining 11/12/13/14 st for the shoulder.

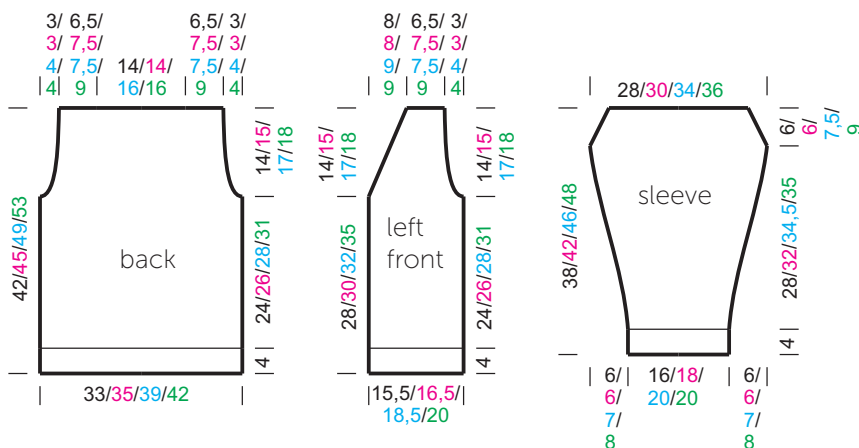
### Sleeves

Using the 5.0 mm needle and Rainbow, cast on 28/32/34/34 st and work in the border pattern for 4 cm. Change to the 5.5 mm needle and continue working in stockinette st. In the 5th/7th/7th/5th row after the cuff, increase 1 st at each edge; then increase 1 st at each edge in every 6th R 8x /in every 8th R 8x /in every 8th R 4x and in every 6th R 6x /in every 6th R 12x = 46/50/56/60 st.

When the sleeve measures 32/36/38.5/39 cm from the cast-on edge, shape the sleeve cap: decrease 1 st at each edge after or before the selvage st in every other row 5/5/6/7x. When the piece measures 38/42/46/59 cm from the cast-on edge, bind off the remaining 36/40/44/46 st.

Work the second sleeve in the same way.

### FINISHING OFF

Dampen and block all pieces according to the measurements; allow to dry.

Sew the shoulder seams. Sew in sleeves. Sew side and sleeve seams.

### Front border

Using the long 5.0 mm circular needle and Rainbow, pick up and knit 155/169/187/199 st, evenly spaced, from the front edges and neck opening, working 3 st out of every 2 edge st as follows: bottom of left front up to shoulder seam 66/72/80/86 st, back of neck 23/25/27/27 st, shoulder seam to bottom of right front 66/72/80/86 st.

Work in the border pattern for 2.5 cm, beginning Row 1 (WS) with selvage st, p1, k1 and ending with k1, p1, selvage st. In the right-side border, work the buttonholes in Row 4 as follows:

Word 2 st in pattern, yo, work 2 st tog in pattern, \*work 8/9/10/11 st in pattern, yo, work 2 st tog in pattern, repeat from \* 4x. Work the remaining st in the row in pattern. In the WS row, work the yarnovers in the pattern. Then bind off all st loosely as they appear.

Weave in all ends.
